Our Vision

We envision a world in peace, ruled by the Prince of Peace, Jesus Christ our Lord in which all things will be made new and put under the sovereign authority of God (1 Cor. 15:24-25).

Our Mission

The Peace and Reconciliation Network (PRN) is a worldwide movement of Evangelical Christians for peace building and restoration ministries. We seek peace between people and God and peace between people in their respected communities. For us peace building is an integral part of the mission of God on Earth and reconciliation the heart of peace building. Being made new in Christ we lift up the word of reconciliation in the world as our task and commission (2 Cor. 5:17-20). We do this together with all those who understand the call of God.

Our Strategy

The PRN works through peace builders in churches and Evangelical agencies. We call our corporate agents - *strategic partners* and the individual – *ambassadors for peace*. All of them follow in one way or another our TRAIN Strategy:

- a) training or promoting training for peace and reconciliation;
- b) mediating or promoting mediation in conflicting situations;
- c) assisting those who are directly involved in peace building and reconciliation;
- d) helping to initiate projects where there is no local initiative formed yet;
- e) supporting the network as such by adding information, creating friendships, etc.

The Nature of an Ambassador of Peace

Ambassadors of Peace are more than supporters of peace building and reconciliation. In fact, they raise and motivate other potential supporters to become active. They think strategically and work creatively to support the network to function.

How do you become an Ambassador of Peace?

Do you feel an urgent need for peace building in the world? Does the conflict loaded world around you cause pain in your heart? Do you sense an inward call to work for reconciliation among people and God and people and their neighbors? Then you are best equipped to start as an Ambassador of Peace. PRN will equip you through additional training for your specific mission inside the movement. Please connect with our PRN personnel and together we will work on a personal involvement plan for you.

Is the Ambassador of Peace a fulltime position?

You might consider to be involved fulltime with PRN. Especially pensioners, who are no longer concerned with their income, are invited to spend their best years for the Lord and for peace in the world. But also young people can become peacemakers, who start in life and are not yet too occupied with the daily worries of life. Most of our Ambassadors of Peace are volunteers. But their contribution to PRN is enormous.
